Llangrannog - Penbryn

Out and About

Why not take the Cardi Bach and try some of the walks highlighted.

Cardigan - Mwnt

Follow paths and quite country roads from the market town of Cardigan, through the village of Y Ferwig, reaching the coast at Mwnt (National Trust). The whitewashed

church at Mwnt dates from the 13th or 14th century.

Aberporth – Tresaith

The walk follows the Coast Path between the villages of Aberporth and Tresaith. Both villages were once important centres for the sailing ships that plied Cardigan Bay and beyond.

Llangrannog - Penbryn

Coastal walk form Llangrannog to Penbryn. Or take a circular walk

from the coastal village of Llangrannog around Ynys Lochtyn (National Trust). The promontory of Ynys Lochtyn is an excellent place for viewing the wildlife of the Bay.

New Quay - Cwmtymdu

Spectacular cliff-top walk linking New Quay and the secluded cove at Cwmtymdu. Coastal wildlife can be seen from the renovated former Coastguard lookout at Birds Rock. Drop in at the 'Boat Place' in New Quay to find out more about Cardigan Bay Special Area of Conservation and the measures being taken to protect the local population of Bottlenose Dolphin.
